Cicero Library Update on Public Services

Visiting the Library

Starting Monday, October 5th, appointments are no longer required to visit the Cicero Public Library but are recommended as occupancy is still limited and adults may only enter the building at appointment times. Visits are still limited to Cicero residents. Adults may use the library for a maximum of one hour per day and must present proof of Cicero residency.

Children who present a school ID from Dist. 99, Dist. 201, Morton College, or a private school located in Cicero will now be allowed in the library and may enter the library outside of the stated appointment times. Children are not subject to the one-hour limit but must be engaged in schoolwork. Children with a Cicero Public Library card may use computers, with limits. In accordance with the library's unsupervised child policy, children under 8 years old must be accompanied by a parent or responsible caregiver. Children who visit with a parent or caregiver do not need to present a school ID.

We have added two appointment slots Monday through Friday in the evenings. The first appointment slot on Wednesdays, from 9:30-10:30 a.m., will be reserved for senior citizens.
